Details, details details.....

Okay, so how do you set the session up, and what happens?

First, contact me either by email at Greg@GregoryJohnPhotography.com, or call me at 262-527-3380.

Ask all the questions you need to ask.

You'll need to have a few dates and times in mind, and a pretty good idea of how long you would want the photo shoot to last (See the Session Pricing link on the Portraits Page). Then we'll connect either through email or on the phone and set things up. You're paying me for my time to do the session... Check out the Pricing link on the Portraits Page. If I do a shoot at your location, some of the time is for my setup. I like to try and get there a little before the time of the scheduled shoot to assess things so I can make sure I can set up okay.

Before we start there is an agreement, or contract, to sign. You pay me for the session time before we do the shoot. I can also take Visa, Master Card or Discover.

If I am doing the shoot at your home or another location, you'll need to make sure there is ample space. I need about a 10' x 10' area (more or less) for lighting, camera and backdrop equipment. If an outdoor spot is available that should be neat, uncluttered and safe to work in.

If you have purchased a Standard / On Location shoot, you can change clothes or hairstyles as often as you would like in that Session Time. If for some reason you come up with more outfit changes than you planned, you can purchase additional time as long as it fits my schedule—I'll stay if I can.

I will take the shots and do some minor cropping on them to create a set of proofs for you to review. I put these online, under a password. Printed or CD proofs are optional.

You select images you want, we'll talk over what kind of corrections you might want to them, if any. Think about the sizes and quantity of photographs you'll want, along with any products you would be interested in, and together we'll create an order. You'll pay me 75% of the order at that time. You can order as little or as much as you want. There are no minimums, no packages.

I then take the images, edit, correct or have the ProLab do the corrections and put together your order. Time on the order varies but most things can be completed within a week or two, depending on how busy the photo lab is and exactly what is being done. You pay me the remaining 25% when I deliver the order.

For Senior portraits (or any yearbook picture for that matter), you will select that image and retouching if needed. I will take care of creating the final product. You will get a chance to review that (time permitting) before I submit it to the Yearbook 'person' that handles the Yearbook for your school.
